## Financial Aid and SAP

Academic progress is made up of two parts:

- 1. Your cumulative GPA, includes all of your OCCC credits AND any credits taken through PCC directly.
- 2. The percentage of your credits that you successfully complete each term. Successful completion is earning a grade of A, B, C, D, or P.

**Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)** applies to any student using financial aid. The standards are the same as Academic Standing, 2.0 cumulative GPA and successful completion of 67 percent of cumulative credits taken. A key difference is that students who do not meet SAP requirements for **two** terms may be suspended from using financial aid. Success coaches can assist students in submitting an appeal if appropriate.
